Alexandra Partridge - Soloist

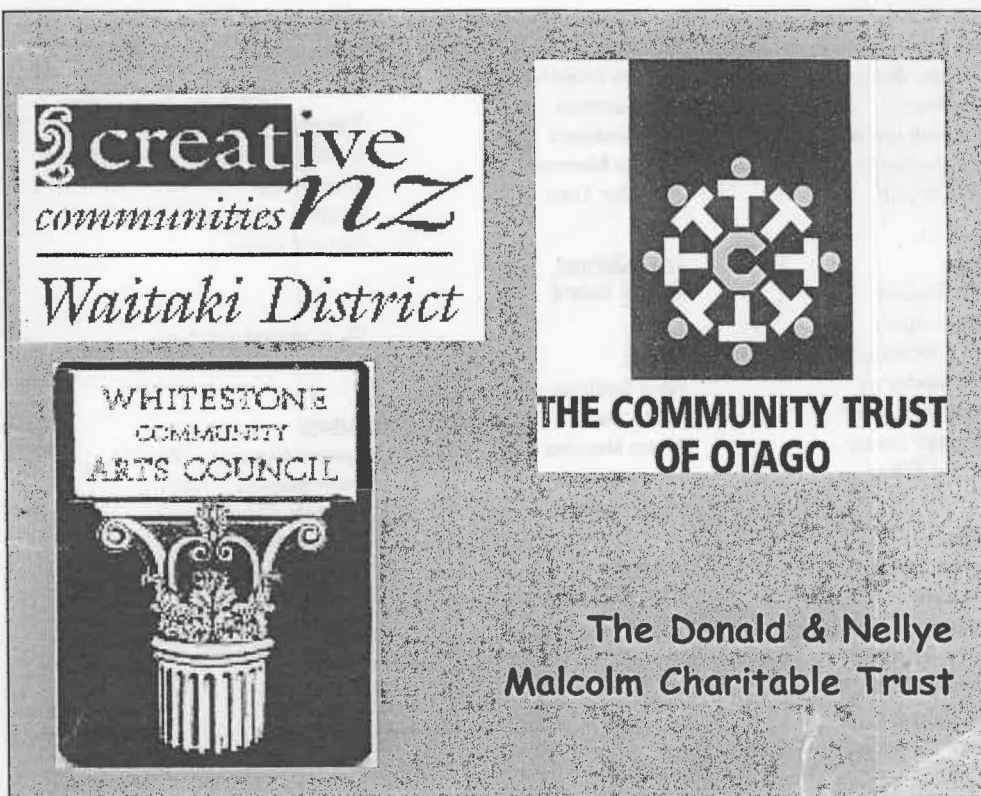
