The tutors (see last page) have once again given much of their considerable experience and talents to produce today's orchestra and group performances. We are most grateful for their efforts.

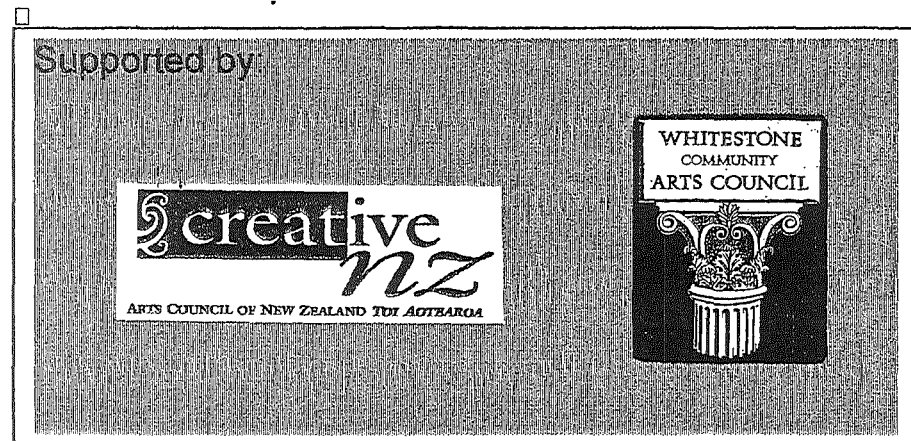
